

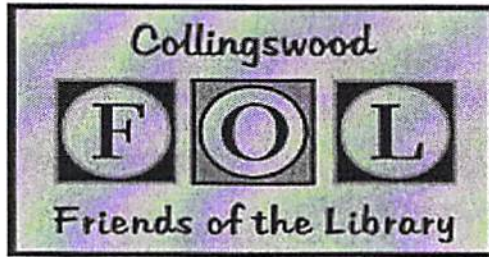
- Is a graduating, college-bound senior from Collingswood Public High School, the homeschool equivalent, or a Collingswood resident graduating from a school outside of Collingswood
